
























Some fifty students at Grahm Junior College. in Boston began a hunger strike last Tuesday in an attempt to stop the college's closure.

brought bankruptcy proceedings into the Massachusetts courts.








Unless you will have learned to communicate blatantly your nausea over man's inhumanity to man ... you will have learned nothing.



As you leave our Academic Community and move on into other endeavors, please know that you take with you my deepest respect and love. In every sense, you have been a real part of our extended family.


